WHY INTERSEED?

-OBTAIN COVER CROP BENFITS WITH FULL SEASON C-B Var. -ABLE TO SEED MORE DIVERSITY COMPARED TO FALL SEEDING -TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE GROWING SEASON. LONGER DURATION OF MORE LIVE ROOTS IN THE SOIL

-TIMING FITS SIDEDRESSING NITROGEN

-Interseeded 10lbs Annual Ryegrass, 4 lbs Radish, 4 lbs White Clover per acre with JD spreader on June 26, 2014. Used Urea to carry, spread 60feet. Cover Crop and check strips yielded the same. Roundup only used.
